We Also Recommend, That You Edit The mappingdrive.bat file.
To Read As Follows:-

```
subst R: /d <<< You Can Change The Mapped Drive Letter Here !!!!
subst R: %1 <<< You Can Change The Mapped Drive Letter Here !!!!
explorer R:\Your_Index_File.Html or R:\Your_Index_File.pdf
```

On Loading, This Will Display Your Own Default Index Page !!!!

Please note, that your in document links syntax, should look as follows:-
`file:///R:/your_pdf_file.pdf#page=??`

Please note, that AutoMapper Can Also Be Used To Map A Drive On Your Hard Drive.
For Example:-

`C:\Users\LeagueLoch\Documents\Legal`
